Re: the request for a rate increase to the ICR Water in Prescott, AZ

I find this very interesting.

Questions we need answers to before any rate increase.....!!!!!!.....

Why is Talking Rock Ranch (TRR golf course) not paying across the board the same as we are as per ACC Decision Number 64360?

\$0.03 per 1000 gals vs \$2.00 per 1000 as per ACC Decision Number 64360 and now we are paying \$2.80 per 1000 galshow is this FAIR.....?????? And they want an increased rate??? The ADWR and TRR agreement said ALL Metered taps are the same????? ACC Decision Number 64360

Where is the new 600,000 gal storage tank that ADWR required TRR to build? Per ACC Decision Number 64360

Why have not the correct wells been transferred?? As per ACC Decision Number 64360 ICR Water received the 3rd well drilled and the least producing well instead of the 1st drilled and best producing well, that ADWR said we shall receive, What about the 2nd well we were to receive?????

What about back fees due to incorrect rate to TRR? Still charged .03 cents per 1000 gals when ACC Decision Number 64360 clearly states all metered taps are the same and shall be charged The same (2.00 per 1000 gals)

CM 2.11 Is the golf course watered with potable or effluent water? Who furnishes this Water? What is the cost of this water per 1,000 gallons to ICR and to the golf Course?

Response: Landscaping for the golf course is watered with potable water, and the golf course's lakes are watered with effluent. The potable water is pumped from three Wells and delivered through ICR's water system to the golf course pursuant to the Well Agreement. I l k Well Agreement is endosed in the response to CM 2.12 And is more particularly described in the response to CM 2.16. The golf course Currently pays \$11.59 per acre feet as a pumping charge for delivering water to The golf course. **(gallons per acre-foot equals 325851.385 gallons.) [\$0.0356 cents per thousand]** **The** rate is adjusted annually per the Well Agreement. The Effluent used to water the storage lake is delivered pursuant to a separate contract Between ICR Sanitary District (not affiliated with ICR) and the golf course.
