Public Notice

Total Coliform Bacteria

This notice is to inform customers of Mt. Tipton Water Co., Inc., PWS# 08-059, that the water system violated the maximum contaminant level for coliform bacteria for the months of December, 2006 and April, 2007. The water system also failed to monitor the water for total coliforms during the month of September, 2007. These previous problems have been resolved.

Total coliforms: *“Coliforms are bacteria that are naturally present in the environment and are used as an indicator that other, potentially harmful, bacteria may be present. Coliforms were found in more samples than allowed and this was a warning of potential problems.”*

Due to a new board of directors' reorganization, and a new certified operator, we failed to take samples of our water system for the month of September, 2007. Because we exceeded the limits of coliforms for the months of December, 2006 and April, 2007, we are regulated by law to notify the public. MTWC has been monitoring the water, and has had no violations since the month of September, 2007.
