NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 28, 2000, the Arizona Electric Division of Citizens Communications Company ("Citizens") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application to change the current purchased power and fuel adjustment clause rate ("PPFAC"), to establish a new PPFAC bank, and to begin accruing carrying charges and to request approved guidelines for the recovery of costs incurred in connection with energy risk management initiatives ("Application").

On January 8, 2002, Marshall Magruder and Lucy Magruder filed Requests to Intervene.

On January 31, 2002, Citizens filed its Response to the Magruders' Request to Intervene, objecting to the intervention. Citizens states that the Magruders were intervenors in the recent Siting Committee Case No. 111 and Citizens believes that the Magruders want to discuss potential future need and rate impacts associated with construction of the 345/115 kV interconnection project in Santa Cruz County. Citizens believes that intervention would unduly broaden the issues involved in this PPFAC docket. Citizens requests that if intervention is granted, that the Magruders be advised that the issues concerning the interconnection project are irrelevant and immaterial to this proceeding, and that the Magruders be designated a "class of interested persons" and only one be allowed to act as spokesperson.

On February 5, 2002, the Magruders filed their "Comments Concerning Citizens' Letter of 31

1 January 2002 and the Request to Intervene by Marshall Magruder.” In the Comments, the Magruders
2 state that they are Citizens electric utility ratepayers and further discuss their concerns about the rate
3 impact of the PPFAC. Accordingly, they should be granted intervention. However, their intervention
4 will not be allowed to broaden the issues in this matter. In order to assist the Magruders in
5 identifying the scope of the issues in this matter, Citizens shall provide the Magruders with copies of
6 the application including the amendments and any exhibits thereto and copies of its filed testimony
7 and exhibits, and all parties shall provide the Magruders with copies of their testimony and exhibits
8 already filed. Further, pursuant to A.A.C.R14-2-105(C), the Magruders are declared to a class of
9 interested persons for purposes of the hearing, and shall designate one to be a spokesperson.

10 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the requests to intervene by Marshall Magruder and
11 Lucy Magruder are hereby granted.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Citizens and the parties to this matter shall provide the
13 Magruders with the documents as identified hereinabove.

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
