STAFF'S NOTICE OF FILING LATE-FILED EXHIBIT

On March 14, 2008, a consolidated hearing in the above-captioned matters was held before the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC"), presided over by Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Marc E. Stern.

At the hearing, the applicant, Wilhoit Water Company, Inc. ("Wilhoit"), presented information supporting all three applications. ACC Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") presented its own analysis, including Staff's recommended rate design. Wilhoit questioned Staff's calculations regarding the revenue which would be produced under Staff's proposed rate design. At the close of hearing, Wilhoit was still unsatisfied with the answers Staff had provided on record and expressed this concern to Judge Stern.

Judge Stern ordered the parties to schedule a meeting at which Staff would demonstrate the methodology by which the revenue calculations were produced. The parties were further ordered to file a "joint stipulation from [Staff] and the company that [the parties] have reviewed the analysis by

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1 [Staff's] utility analyst there, that an explanation has been provided to the company". [Tr., 97, 18-21]
