**INSUFFICIENCY LETTER #2**

Dear Mr. Robertson:

In reference to the above-mentioned application filed on December 14, 2007, this letter is to inform you that the application has still not met sufficiency requirements under the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C."). The following actions need to be taken or information provided in order to determine sufficiency:

1. File an amended application in the above-referenced docket that: (1) Deletes Sahuarita Unified School District's acreage within the Town of Sahuarita from the proposed CC&N extension, and (2) requests that the existing CC&N be reissued to Sahuarita Water Company in order to reflect the recent change in name from Rancho Sahuarita Water company, L.L.C. to Sahuarita Water Company, L.L.C.
2. Provide information addressing when the Company will actually begin construction in the area requested in the CC&N extension that is not currently within its certified territory?
3. Provide a copy of the required city or county permit(s) and/or franchise(s).

Staff would like to use this opportunity to bring the following to your attention:

- Pursuant to the A.A.C. R-14-2-411(C), upon meeting sufficiency requirements, the Commission has 150 days for its substantive review. This includes conducting a hearing and preparing an Opinion and Order to present to the Commission at an Open Meeting; and
