We would like to take this opportunity to thank you and your staff for your time and efforts in reviewing documentation, hearing testimony and investigating the merits of this ICR Water Users Association Rate Case. The diligence you and your staff have given to the merits of this case are appreciated by all of us. The conclusions, recommendations and testimony of ACC Staff in ACC

Decision 64360 was quite clear and easily understood.

As shareholders of the ICR Water Users Association, this rate case has given us the opportunity to learn how the ACC process works. We are impressed with the process. It has also been enlightening to see how the process can be ignored or subverted, intentional or un-intentional.

We are particularly dismayed that the ICR Water Users Association Board of Directors, in conjunction with Harvard, invested over a year in what appears to be intentional subversion of ACC Decision 64360. The testimony of your staff and Mr. Dayne Taylor clearly identifies the issues.

We believe the summaries and recommendations of your staff are clear. The Company must comply with ACC Decision 64630. The prior executed agreements between the Company and Harvard must be declared void. New agreements must be instituted to comply with Decision 64630 and the current recommendations and decisions from this rate case. Prior bad faith actions should not be tolerated.

We want to thank you for your efforts in behalf of the shareholders and rate payers, and providing us an opportunity to be heard in this matter.
