PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On October 18, 2007, Farmers Water Company ("FWC" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an Extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN" or "Certificate") to provide water service in Pima County, Arizona.

On November 16, 2007, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") notified the Company that its application was not sufficient pursuant to the Arizona Administrative Code.

On January 28, 2008, FWC responded to Staff's Insufficiency Letter.

On February 26, 2008, Staff notified the Company that its Application is sufficient pursuant to the Arizona Administrative Code.

On March 18, 2008, a Procedural Order was issued setting a hearing in this docket for May 9, 2008, at the Commission's Tucson offices.

On April 1, 2008, Staff filed a Motion to Amend Procedural Order. Staff stated that there was a conflict with Staff witnesses on May 9, 2008. Staff contacted the Company and the Company agreed to a change in date of the hearing. As such, Staff requested that the hearing date be vacated and reset.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
10 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. §40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission  
11 *pro hac vice*.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
13 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
14 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearing at all  
15 hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled  
16 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
17 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
19 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's  
20 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time clock for issuing a Decision in this matter is  
22 extended accordingly.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
24 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


