Dear Mr. Heyman:

In your April 23, 2008 correspondence regarding the agreement in principle which has been reached in settlement of the currently pending above-referenced proceedings, you indicate that Tucson Electric Power Company "will soon request from the Commission either a revised procedural schedule or a procedural conference regarding the Settlement Agreement."

In that regard, and as you are aware from comments I made during the settlement negotiations last week, I will be involved in hearings before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee in Phoenix on May 12-13, 2008. Accordingly, Mesquite Power, L.L.C., Southwestern Power Group II, L.L.C., Bowie Power Station, L.L.C. and Semptra Energy Solutions would appreciate your considering a revised procedural schedule and/or procedural conference which contemplates a date other than May 12-13, 2008 for the presentation of evidence in support of the forthcoming Settlement Agreement. Subject to review and approval of the language of the forthcoming Settlement Agreement, as finalized, my clients anticipate that we will be supporting the same, and would like to have an opportunity to actively participate in any evidentiary hearing proceeding involving the presentation of evidence in support of the settlement.
