PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 20, 2008, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission"), in Decision No. 70196 (March 20, 2008), approved the application of IPC Network Services, Inc. ("IPC") for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide resold point-to-point private line telecommunications services in Arizona. The Decision required IPC to procure a performance bond or an irrevocable sight draft letter of credit in the amount of \$35,000 and to file the original bond or irrevocable sight draft letter of credit with the Commission's Business Office within 30 days of the effective date of the Decision.

On April 22, 2008, IPC filed a request for a fourteen day extension of time to comply with Decision No. 70196 in filing its performance bond or irrevocable sight draft letter of credit. IPC stated it has been unable to secure said bond or irrevocable sight draft letter of credit due to difficulties with its lender and confusion as to the form of the bond or irrevocable sight draft letter of credit.

Accordingly, Staff should file a response to IPC's request for an extension of time to comply with Decision No. 70196.


