Dear Chairman Gleason:

We reside in Phase II-Sun City and not in Phase I, where the fire flow issue is proposed.

It is imperative that this improvement take place to save lives.

The fire flow capacity is insufficient to fight a fire in any of the small, older-Phase I houses that are inhabited by an elderly and frequently disabled population.

The impact and plan benefits more homes in Sun City than Youngtown or Peoria. It would be foolish not to consider lives over a mere 17.5 cents per 1,000 gallons a month. Where is the value of human life to consider? Do we only want to hold tight to what effects me? Should we not consider the future and making a needed improvement that will benefit all of Phase I Sun City? Sustaining Sun City's future means we have to invest in changes, improvements and apply vision.

We urge you to approve this issue. It is a vote for the future and for public safety.
