I am opposed to the requested rate increase that Johnson Utilities has submitted.

At this time Johnson Utilities charges 38.50 a month for Sewer and 27.00 minimum for water a month. Then after the minimum water usage the rates go up from there. That does not include taxes, meter reading fees and other misc. charges. This is already more than double the fees being charged to those that live in Maricopa County or Pima County.

I therefore submit that these current charges are too high and submit that they be lowered at least 25%.
