PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 27, 2008, Tonto Village Water Company, Inc. ("Tonto Village" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an increase in rates in Docket No. W-01580A-07-0707 ("Rate Case").

On January 22, 2008, the Company filed a Certification of Publication in the Rate case docket.

On January 25, 2008, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Letter of Deficiency in the Rate Case, and directed Tonto Village to supplement its application.

On January 29, 2008, the Tonto Village Domestic Water Improvement District ("District") filed Motion to Intervene in the Rate Case.

On February 25, 2008, Tonto Village filed additional information in support of its rate application.

On March 26, 2008, Staff filed a Letter of Sufficiency, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-103.B.7, and classified Tonto Village as a Class D water utility.

On April 22, 2008, Tonto Village filed with the Commission a financing application in Docket No. W-01580A-08-0209 ("Finance Case").

1 On May 2, 2008, the Tonto Village Domestic Water Improvement District ("District") filed a
2 letter regarding communications between the District and Ron Standage, the Company's president.
3 The District's letter described concerns with respect to negotiations regarding its efforts to acquire
4 the Company's assets. The District also filed on May 2, 2008, a Motion to Intervene in the Finance
5 Case.

6 On May 6, 2008, Mr. Standage, on behalf of Tonto Village, filed a letter in response to the
7 District's letter. The Company also filed on May 6, 2008, an Affidavit of Mailing Customer Notice
8 in the Finance Case.

9 On May 7, 2008, Staff filed a Motion to Suspend the Timeclock in the Rate Case, based on
10 delayed responses to data requests by the Company and its request for consolidation with the Finance
11 Case docket.

12 On May 19, 2008, a Procedural Order was issued consolidating the above-captioned dockets,
13 granting Staff a 60-day extension of time to file its Staff Report, and extending the time clock by 60
14 days for the Rate Case docket.

15 On June 5, 2008, Staff filed a Motion to Suspend Timeclock due to requests by Tonto Village
16 for additional time to respond to Staff data requests. Given the repeated delays in responses by the
17 Company, Staff seeks an indefinite extension of the applicable time clock rules.

18 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, for good cause shown, **Staff's Motion to suspend**
19 **Timeclock is hereby granted and the applicable timeclock rules shall be suspended indefinitely**
20 pending a subsequent ruling.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
22 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
23 hearing.
