1 For the information of the Commission, the Chief Administrative Law Judge and
2 all other parties, AZAG provides the following:

3 Each member of AZAG is party to an individual wholesale electric contract with
4 Arizona Public Service Company ("APS"). Charges incurred by AZAG members under
5 those contracts are affected by cost allocations within and between APS operational
6 functions (e.g., generation, transmission, distribution, and administrative services) and
7 customer rate classes; and a material charge component is indexed to APS retail rates at
8 issue in this proceeding. Therefore, each member of AZAG has a material interest in and
9 will be directly affected not only by the underlying base rate case issues, but also by the
10 recently filed Motion for Approval of Interim Rate and Preliminary Order.


