PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 8, 2007, UCN, Inc. ("UCN"), on behalf of Extelcom, Inc. d/b/a Express Tel ("Extelcom"), filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for Cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") for Resold Long Distance Telecommunication Services ("Application").

On March 20, 2007, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Letter of Insufficiency and First Set of Data Requests to Extelcom.

On April 6, 2007, Extelcom filed its Responses to Staff's First Set of Data Requests.

On May 16, 2008, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending cancellation of the CC&N. The Staff Report does not contain certain statutory or regulatory information necessary for the approval of the Application.

Accordingly, Staff should file an amended Staff Report with the Commission in this docket providing the necessary information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff shall file an amended Staff Report on this matter with any appropriate recommendations no later than **4:00 p.m. September 19, 2008.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the amended Staff Report, Staff shall address the following issues:

1 1. Applicability of A.R.S. § 40-285(A) to this matter, specifically whether Extelcom and
2 UCN were required to obtain Commission approval before consummating the sale of Extelcom's
3 assets to UCN;


4 2. Compliance by Extelcom with the requirements of Arizona Administrative Code
5 ("A.A.C.") R14-2-1107;

6 3. Compliance by Extelcom with the requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-1901 – 1913 and
7 A.A.C. R14-2-2001 – 2007 ("Slamming and Cramming Rules");

8 4. Compliance by Extelcom with the requirements of the A.A.C. R14-2-801 – 14-2-806
9 ("Public Utility Holding Companies and Affiliated Interests Rules"); and

10 5. Staff shall further make recommendations regarding Extelcom's tariffs.


