In reading the information contained in the Arizona Republic for the last week concerning Arizona Public Service (APS) request for "Interim Rate Increase" is ridiculous as well as ludicrous. APS says that in order to continue with their infrastructure work for the next three years they will have to cut \$500 million from planned investments. This is to improve the company's "deteriorated" finances. Then on the other hand they say they made a quarterly profit of \$133.9 million. Plus APS turns around and gives one of the executives a pay raise of \$252,000 per year upping his annual base salary by \$800,000 and \$1 million a year in deferred compensation for four years. We of course do not know at this point what amount of pay raise and deferred compensation the other executives were given for the year. Hopefully, you and the rest of the committee will find out. The one executive might be the best in the business but even he can not spend that much money before he dies. Part of this money should be put back into the infrastructure so that the general populace does not need any more pay hikes. Why does APS need financial help to reliably meet customer needs? It sounds like they have enough "spare" money laying around to do there own help.

The information also states that parent company Pinnacle West who also own SunCor Development Co.,

I think any further rates increases for the APS should be denied. The burden of increased costs should be put on APS to use their revenues more effectively, instead of placing the burden on the customers. Our rates are already too high,

Being in Arizona for less than a year, we try to use most of our electricity between 9 pm and 9 am to take advantage of the lower rates. Still we had an electric bill exceeding \$400. Part of this I attribute to an air conditioner that was broken and continued to nm without cooling. However, when I looked closely at our bill, I was shocked when I realized, most of the fees were not even for the electricity!

I have enclosed a copy of my bill, if you care to review it. In a nutshell, I paid \$215.80 for actual electricity used, but ancillary fees totaling \$152.84, plus and additional \$42.25 in taxes. More than half of my bill is ancillary fees. What is wrong with this! Is it even legal? And, for APS to want even more money is outrageous.

APS announced a \$133.9 million profit earned from April to June. Those profits were boosted by unusual circumstances, including a \$30 million tax benefit and big sale in its real-estate division. Excluding the tax benefit and the office-building sale, Pinnacle West still earned \$84.9 million, \$5.9 million more for the quarter than a year ago, a 7.4 percent increase. The company is seeking a rate increase from the Arizona Corporation Commission, and has urged its approval because of its "deteriorated" financial position.

Officials down played the profits, emphasizing that APS is earning about an 8.5 percent return on its investments, less than the 10.75 percent it is legally allowed to earn. 8.5% return? Where can I get 8.5% these

days as my assets shrivel up and my basic living expenses keep increasing. Exxon makes 8 percent, and people want them to be nationalized or pay a windfall tax. Public utility companies are supposed to serve the public and should be non-profit.

Last month APS gave the vice president in charge of Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station a \$252,000 raise - upping his annual base salary to \$800,000 - and \$1 million a year in deferred compensation for four years. The US President has a salary of \$400K per year. How can anyone think that this public utility employee deserves 2 million a year with his salary and all the benefits and stock options while most of us are turning up our air conditioners to 80 degrees or more so we can pay the electric bill and still buy food?

Commissioners, please think twice before you rubber stamp this rate request!
