FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On July 18, 2005, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 67986, which approved a rate increase for Oak Creek Utility Corporation ("Oak Creek" or "Company") and for authority to issue promissory note(s) and other evidence of indebtedness payable at periods of more than twelve months after the date of issuance.

2. Decision No. 67986 also ordered Oak Creek to complete a 10,000 gallon storage tank and file the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") Approval of Construction for the project, both within 18 months of the effective date of the Decision.

3. By Procedural Order issued November 17, 2006, the Company was granted an extension, until May 31, 2007, to construct the storage tank and submit the required ADEQ documentation.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED Oak Creek Utility Corporation is hereby granted an additional extension of time, until May 31, 2009, to construct the 10,000 gallon storage tank and file the ADEQ Approval of Construction, as required by Decision No. 67986. The Company shall also comply with all other ADEQ requirements related to the project by May 31, 2009, including installation of necessary booster pumps.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED no additional extensions of time shall be granted for compliance with the storage tank construction requirement, absent extraordinary circumstances.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
