PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 15, 2008, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a formal complaint against the Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPSCO").

On July 24, 2008, AEPSCO filed a Motion to Extend Answer/Response Time To August 15, 2008. SSVEC did not object.

By Procedural Order dated July 28, 2008, the deadline for AEPSCO to file an Answer/Response to the Complaint was extended until August 15, 2008.

On August 1, 2008, Mohave Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Mohave") filed an Application to Intervene. Mohave is a partial requirements member of AEPSCO, and claims it will be directly and substantially affected by the proceedings in this docket.

On August 15, 2008, AEPSCO filed its Answer to the Complaint.

On August 19, 2008, SSVEC filed a Request for Procedural Conference for the purpose of discussing a schedule and date for an evidentiary hearing; the presentation of evidence; procedures for discovery and any other relevant matters.

No party objected to Mohave's request to intervene.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **Procedural Conference** for the purpose of establishing guidelines and a schedule in this matter shall commence on **September 4, 2008, at 10:30**

3 **participate is (602) 771-9964.**


4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Staff shall appear** at the September 4, 2008 Procedural
