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

**STAFF'S MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF DEADLINE**

10 By procedural order filed on July 24, 2008, Arizona Corporation Commission
11 ("Commission") Railroad Safety Section Staff ("Staff") was directed to file a Staff report by August
12 29, 2008 regarding the above captioned matter. Due to unforeseen circumstances, Staff will not be
13 able to file the Staff report on August 29 and requests an extension of the filing deadline to Friday
14 September 5, 2008.

15 On the night of August 28, 2008 a severe storm struck in the Phoenix area. Among the
16 locations affected was the Commission Railroad Safety Section's office in the 2200 N. Central Ave.
17 building. The extent of storm damage has temporarily rendered the building unusable and the
18 building manager has denied access to the building pending repairs. Consequently, Staff is unable to
19 access computer files that contain the pertinent materials for the final Staff report. As it is also a
20 holiday weekend, Staff has been informed that there may be difficulty on the building manager's part
21 in obtaining necessary contractor assistance to return the building to a useable status. Therefore,
22 Staff requests an extension of the filing deadline for the Staff report to September 5.

23 Counsel for the applicant Union Pacific Railroad Company ("Railroad") has been contacted
24 and expressed no opposition to the extension of time. Because the extension will substantially
25 diminish the amount of time available for the Railroad to evaluate and possibly object to the Staff
26 report, Staff proposes extending the time for the Railroad's objections to September 12 from the
27 original September 9 deadline for objections to the Staff report that is set by the July 24 procedural
28 order.
