2 Division at (602) 542-4250 for instructions on participating telephonically.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall reply to the Company's Reply to Staff's
4 Response by October 6, 2008.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall file its testimony and exhibits to be used
6 at hearing by October 20, 2008.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall file testimony and exhibits to be used at hearing
8 by November 3, 2008.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall file its rebuttal testimony and exhibits,
10 if any, by November 13, 2008.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
12 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. §40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*
13 *hac vice*.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or
15 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
16 hearing.


