

16 FINDINGS OF FACT

- 17 1. Litchfield Park Service Company ("Company") is certificated to provide
18 wastewater service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.
19 2. On August 25, 2008, the Company filed for a New Code of Practice Tariff.
20 3. The proposed Tariff sets forth certain waste limitations and pretreatment standards
21 that apply based on the class of commercial/industrial customer served by the Company's
22 wastewater treatment facilities located in Maricopa County, Arizona.
23 4. Customer classes include dental offices, dry cleaners, food service establishments,
24 photo imaging operations, RV parks, and pretreatment for industrial wastes.
25 5. The new tariff, if approved, will govern the type and quality of waste discharged
26 into the Company's wastewater collection system and treated at its wastewater treatment facilities.
27 6. Staff needs additional time to complete its review of the proposed tariff and
28 recommends that the filing be suspended for eighty four (84) days.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

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1. The Company is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV, Section 2, of the Arizona Constitution.
2. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Company and of the subject matter in this Application.
3. The Commission having reviewed the filing and Staff's Memorandum dated September 5, 2008, concludes that it is in the public interest to suspend the filing for eighty four (84) days pursuant to A.R.S. §40-250(B).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this tariff filing be and is hereby suspended for a period of eighty four (84) days, through and including December 17, 2008.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
