**MOTION TO AMEND  
PROCEDURAL ORDER**

22 TRICO ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. ("Trico"), the Applicant in the above  
23 proceedings, moves the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") to amend the Procedural Order  
24 issued by the ALJ September 18, 2008, by extending from November 17, 2008 to  
25 December 31, 2008, the date that a copy of the Public Notice set forth in the Procedural

1 Order is to be mailed to each of Trico's customers upon the following grounds and for the  
2 following reasons:

3 Trico has discussed this Motion with the Arizona Corporation Commission's Staff  
4 ("Staff") and Staff has no objections to this Motion.

5 The Procedural Order sets forth, among other things:

6 1. The hearing before the ALJ is set for May 20, 2009.

7 2. Applications to Intervene must be filed no later than February 13, 2009.

8 3. The first written testimony to be filed in the proceeding is to be filed on or  
9 before February 27, 2009.

10 4. The form of the Public Notice to be mailed and published by Trico is set  
11 forth verbatim in the Procedural Order. It provides, among other things, that Trico's  
12 Application requests a rate increase in annual revenues of \$6,542,728, an approximately  
13 8.81 percent increase in annual revenue over its current revenue.

14 Trico, in order to reduce its expenses to a minimum, mails notices to its customers  
15 through National Information Solutions Cooperative ("NISC") in St. Louis, Missouri, with  
16 the Trico bills sent to Trico's customers by first class mail. Such monthly bills are sent out  
17 by cycle over a one month period.

18 In the proceedings pending with the Commission entitled "*In the Matter of the*  
19 *Application of Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. for a Rate Increase, Docket No.*  
20 *E-01773A-04-0528*" and "*In the Matter of the Application of Southwest Transmission*  
21 *Cooperative, Inc. for a Rate Increase, Docket No. E-04100A-04-0527,*" Arizona Electric  
22 Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPCO") increased its Fuel and Purchase Power Cost Adjuster  
23 authorized by the Commission from September 1, 2008 to October 1, 2008 to AEPCO's  
24 All Requirements Members, including Trico, by 11.98 mills per kWh. Such increase  
25 required Trico to increase its Wholesale Power Cost Adjuster from 21 mills to 28 mills and  
26

1 to give written notice of such increase through NISC to all of its customers. Such notice is  
2 being given throughout the month of October, 2008.


3 In order to complete the mailing by NISC to all of Trico's customers of the Public  
4 Notice by November 17, 2008, Trico will be required to cause NISC to commence to send  
5 copies of the Public Notice to Trico's customers on October 13, 2008.

6 Trico is informed and believes and therefore alleges that two notices of substantial  
7 rate increases mailed to each of Trico's customers simultaneously will result in confusion  
8 of the purposes of the separate notices by the Customers which will create potential  
9 adverse public relations for both Trico and Staff.

10 Accordingly, granting this motion will enable Trico to avoid sending such two  
11 notices of rate increases to its customers and that sending the Public Notice to its customers  
12 at a later date will mitigate such adverse public relations.
