PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On February 21, 2007, Broadweave Networks of Arizona ("BNA" or "Applicant") submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate" or "CC&N") to provide resold long distance, resold local exchange and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona ("Application") and requesting that its services be classified as competitive.

On January 11, 2008, Staff filed its Staff Report.

On April 8, 2008, BNA filed its Request for Temporary Stay of Proceeding, and on April 14, 2008, a Procedural Order was issued granting the Request for Temporary Stay and directing the Applicant to file a Status Report by October 10, 2008.

On October 6, 2008, BNA filed its Status Report and Request for Additional Stay of Proceeding. The Applicant stated that it is not able to move forward at present and requested a stay of the proceedings for another year. Staff did not oppose the request.

Accordingly, Applicant's Request for Additional Stay of Proceeding is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant shall file a status report with Docket Control in this matter not later than 4:00 p.m., October 9, 2009.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 31 and 38 of the Rules of  
2 the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*  
3 *hac vice*.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
5 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
6 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearing at all  
7 hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled  
8 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
9 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
11 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's  
12 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time clock for issuing a Decision in this matter is  
14 extended accordingly.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
16 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


