Dear Arizona Corporation Commission:

As concerned citizens of Gilbert, we are writing to express our objections to SRP's proposed SANTAN power plant expansion at the Val Vista/Warner site. We have tried to be very objective and , in attempting to inform ourselves , have read about and studied this issue extensively. However, in so doing, we are **STRONGLY** opposed to this major Gilbert expansion.

Our major concern is the environmental/health risk factor. In spite of what SRP claims, we feel that this plant will adversely affect our health because of added pollution. We feel that this plant should not be built in the middle of a residential area but should be located in a more industrial area. We propose that SRP look at an alternative site. We find it very surprising that the state of Arizona would allow a power plant of this magnitude to be located in a residential area. It is our understanding that many (if not most) states have stricter requirements and regulations concerning where such major power plant facilities can be constructed.

We have been talking to many of our neighbors and fellow Gilbert residents and have found that all of them are opposed to this SRP Gilbert expansion but the majority of them do not take the time to express their feelings and opinions via letters, emails, or phone calls. Thus, we are now writing to you to express our concerns and our opposition .
