The Camelback Inn and Sanctuary on Camelback Mountain collectively (the "Resorts"), hereby move the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105. This motion is supported by the following facts and information:

**I. The Resorts should be granted intervention.**

Persons who are "directly and substantially affected by the proceedings" may apply to intervene. A.A.C. R14-3-105. The Resorts' are customers of Arizona-American in the Paradise Valley Water District and the Resorts are therefore directly and substantially affected by this rate case. Moreover, the Resorts were granted intervention in the proceedings that resulted in Decision No. 70488 (Decision No. 70488 at page 3,

1 line 8-9). Many of the rate issues addressed in Decision No. 70488 will be re-examined  
2 in this case, and the Resorts have a continuing interest in those issue.

3 1. As customers of Arizona American, the Resorts are directly and  
4 substantially affected in the outcome of the proceeding.

5 2. The granting of intervenor status to the Resorts will not delay this  
6 proceeding or cause the issues to be unduly broadened.
