



SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- Commercial customers are defined to be all non-residential general metered customers who do not fit into the definitions of Turf or Resale customers.
- Turf customers are defined as those customers who own or operate a turf-related facility, subject to a water allotment established by the Arizona Department of Water Resources.
- Resale customers are defined as those customers who purchase water for distribution and sale to other persons.
- In addition to the collection of its regular rates and charges, the Company shall collect from its customers their proportionate share of any privilege, sales or use tax or other imposition or fee levied upon the utility service furnished by the Company.
- A 1-1/2% late payment penalty charge will be applied to account balances not paid within 30 days after the postmark date of the bill.
