Dear Mr. McNeil;

I am Alma R. Lee Jr. Previously I was President of American Realty and Mortgage Company, Inc., a tiny water system in Pinal County, Arizona.

Just a day or so ago I received a copy of the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge, Lynn Farmer. I wish to inform the Arizona Corporation commission of certain important facts.

1. Both the water franchise and the corporation known as American Realty and Mortgage Company Inc. ceased to exist some months ago.
2. Please be advised that Attorney Joseph W. Lee ceased to be legal counsel for the corporation and withdrew as legal counsel months ago. Also, Joseph W. Lee resigned as Secretary/Treasurer months ago.
3. Further, Joseph W. Lee, as a personal individual was never involved in the water company business.
4. However, the Arizona Corporation Commission has brought suit in 2007 against Joseph W. Lee personally and that case is still pending in Superior Court.

I believe the proposed recommendation (Opinion and Order) of Administrative Law Judge, Lynn Farmer, are grossly in error as to Joseph W. Lee.

I am most amazed that the hearing officer would attack Joseph W. Lee, as an individual and private person that was not a party to the Order To Show Cause proceeding whatsoever. Therefore, I believe the proposed opinion and administrative order is unconstitutional, without due process of law, unlawful and unfair.
