



Dear Chairman Gleason,

I am John Janik President of the Mt. Tipton Water Company in Dolan Springs, AZ. I am appealing to your good sense and judgment to help us solve a problem .

I know in the past Mt. Tipton had a bad reputation due to mismanagement of the company, but these problems are being taken care of by the current Board of Directors which is dedicated to seeing this company succeed. This Board was not elected, but was appointed by the citizens of this community to solve the problems of the water company and I believe we are in the process of seeing the turn around.

Our current problem is the \$20,000 performance bond that is requested by the Commission for our Emergency rate increase. With Mt. Tipton Water Companies reputation and financial situation we are unable to secure a bond at this time and if we don't get an infusion of money soon we will have to give up. We are asking that the commission look at the bond that is being requested and perhaps allow us to self fund an account that would be out of the reach of Mt. Tipton Water Company in the amount of \$10,000. We will seed this account with \$5,000 and put \$1,000 monthly in to the account until we have the \$10,000.

Also, we are in the process of securing permission from the commission to sell a building that has a lien on it from WIFA. We have obtained the ok from WIFA and we are waiting for the ok from the ACC. WIFA gave us permission in about 2 months can you give us a time line as to when we may be able to obtain permission from the ACC. If we do not receive this permission soon we may miss the boat for the sale of this building. This sale would enable us to pay our back taxes, take care of the hook up fees that need to be reimbursed and put some money into our water system which is badly needed.

It seems that any direction we turn at this time there is a brick wall in our path and we are not allowed to proceed. Without the emergency rate increase we will not have the funds to move forward in the process of updating our water system or keeping our doors open. It seems that there is someone that would like to see us close our doors and fail but we are stubborn and will keep trying until the end.

We would like to invite you and or your staff to come to Dolan Springs and see the changes that have been made and to see first hand our situation. With a well down and what ADEQ is requesting we need help!!!! We are not asking for a handout just some consideration for our requests.
