PROCEDURAL ORDER

13 BY THE COMMISSION:

14 On May 20, 2008, in Decision No. 70355, the Arizona Corporation Commission
15 ("Commission") approved a Settlement Agreement between Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") and
16 DIECA Communications, Inc., doing business as Covad Communications Company and Mountain
17 Telecommunications, Inc. ("Covad"); Eschelon Telecom of Arizona, Inc. ("Eschelon"); McLeodUSA
18 Telecommunications Services, Inc. ("McLeod"); and XO Communications Services, Inc. ("XO")
19 (collectively "Joint CLECs").¹ The Settlement Agreement resolved issues between Qwest and the
20 Joint CLECs concerning Qwest's initial list of unimpaired wire centers, and established procedures
21 that would apply between the parties with respect to future Qwest filings to update the unimpaired
22 wire center list.

23 On June 22, 2007, Qwest filed in this docket an application for Approval of 2007 Additions to
24 Non-Impaired Wire Center List ("2007 Additions Application").

25 On June 17, 2008, Qwest filed an Application for approval of 2008 Additions to Non-

1 Impaired Wire Center List (“2008 Additions Application”).

2 Pursuant to the Procedural Order dated August 25, 2008, the following deadlines and
3 procedures were adopted for the processing of Qwest’s 2007 and 2008 Additions Applications:

4 Deadline to Execute Protective Order	September 26, 2008
5 Deadline to File Objection to Qwest designation	October 27, 2008
6 Deadline for Staff Report or Objection	November 12, 2008

7 On October 27, 2008, the Joint CLECs filed objections to approval of the following wire
8 center designations:

- 9 2007 – Super West (SPRSAZWE)
- 10 2008 - Gilbert (MESAAZGI)

11 The Joint CLECs requested a procedural conference to determine procedures for resolving the
12 disputed designations.

13 On November 12, 2008, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed its Comments on
14 Qwest’s 2007 and 2008 Proposed Additions to Non-impaired Wire Center Designations. Staff found
15 the methodology Qwest used for selecting the 2007 and 2008 non-impaired wire center designations
16 to be in compliance with Section V of the Settlement Agreement. Staff states further that it believes
17 the Joint CLECs resolved the objection to the Gilbert wire center. With respect to the Superstition
18 wire center, Staff states it does not have complete information regarding the basis for the Joint CLEC
19 objection and could not offer comments on the merits of the issue and is in process of clarifying the
20 objection through data requests. Staff recommends convening a Procedural Conference to discuss a
21 process for resolving the Joint CLEC objections.


22 On November 13, 2008, the Joint CLECs filed an amended Objection to Qwest’s Proposed
23 Additions. The Joint CLECs confirmed that based on information Qwest provided to them, they are
24 withdrawing their objection to the Gilbert (MESAAZGI) wire center. The Joint CLECs reiterated
25 their request for a Procedural Conference to determine how to proceed.

26 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a telephonic Procedural Conference**, for the purpose of
27 determining how to proceed in this Phase II of these dockets, shall convene on **December 11, 2008,**
28 **at 10:30 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission’s **Tucson office, Room 222,**

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
4 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
5 hearing.
