Dear Ms. Farmer:

The intervenors (residents of Gilbert) are requesting additional time to submit their brief. We are having great difficulty obtaining copies of the transcripts<sup>1</sup> including difficulty in preparing this brief based upon lack of legal representation. We are requesting an extension of time through and including April 9, 2001 to submit our brief.

Next, while we certainly can appreciate the Arizona Corporation Commissions' request to consolidate some of the intervenors (residents of Gilbert), we can not consolidate seven of the intervenors into one spokesperson for a total time of 20 minutes. We suggest that having no more than three spokespersons from the joint request for review filed on February 28, 2001 and we request one and half hours be set-aside for oral argument. This request does not include consolidation of the other request for review filed on February 26, 2001 and February 27, 2001.
