Dear Ms. Farmer:

We represent the Arizona Utility Investors Association (“AUIA”) in the above-referenced matter. We have received a copy of the letter to you from Cathy Lopez (faxed April 2, 2001) requesting (a) an extension to file briefs until April 9, 2001; and (b) an increase in the number of spokesmen and the allotted time at oral argument.

With regard to the requested additional time for filing briefs, AUIA does not object *provided* that all parties file briefs on April 9, 2001, and that this does not delay the scheduled oral argument and subsequent Open Meeting.

Concerning the request for additional spokesmen and time at oral argument, the AUIA does object. AUIA believes that the Procedural Order sets forth a fair, logical and time efficient process for the parties. As we understand the procedure, the oral argument will be limited to matters presented in the briefs that are filed. In essence, the Procedural Order provides one spokesman for each request for review that has been filed, and one spokesman each for the AUIA, Staff and SRP. This approach makes sense to us. There does not seem to be a compelling reason to have multiple spokesmen covering the same view points. Additionally, AUIA believes that 20 minutes per spokesman is a reasonable time. Accordingly, AUIA requests that Ms. Lopez’ request for additional spokesmen and time be denied.
