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Dear Commissioners:

I am writing to clarify my letter of January 31, 2002. In that correspondence, I informed you of SRP's decision to amend its air quality permit application to exclude the technical and regulatory analysis for the emergency burning of distillate fuel at its existing Santan facility. (The new units will not have any diesel burning capability.)

I wanted to provide SRP's rationale for that decision. Before deciding to amend the air permit application, SRP analyzed the risks associated with diesel burning prohibition contained in Condition No. 36 of the Santan Certificate of Environmental Compatibility.

Based on this analysis, SRP does not foresee a significant risk of blackouts as a result of the CEC prohibition at this time. Of course, if the situation changes in the future, SRP will notify the Commission promptly.

I hope that this clarifies SRP's intent. As always, please contact me if you have any additional questions or concerns.
