Page 24, line 5, INSERT: New Finding of Fact:

“Significant testimony was offered during the hearings in this case on the question of whether Utilities, Inc. should be required to adopt purple pipe to the home site for use in outdoors household irrigation. At least one other regulated water Company has announced plans to take purple pipe to the home site for outdoor irrigation, and we take judicial note of the fact that the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality has promulgated a rule that facilitates the use of purple pipe for outdoors residential irrigation (R18-9-701: Direct Reuse of Reclaimed Water). A company witness, Ray Jones, while not testifying in favor of purple pipe to the home site in this case, did state that “the time has come” for the use of recycled water at home sites in Arizona. Additionally, there is testimony in the record that Utilities, Inc., the company that will own and operate these water systems, has hands on experience with constructing and operating residential purple pipe systems, at their Lake Utility Services, Inc. and Alafaya Utilities in Florida. Therefore, we believe it is in the public interest to require, in addition to the conservation measures included in Exhibit I, PMUC to file, as a compliance item in this case, appropriate tariffs for Commission consideration that would require the installation of a treated wastewater reuse system that allows for the reuse of such treated wastewater at individual homes. These tariffs shall contain, at a minimum, the requirements for such reuse, details of the estimated costs of construction and operation, proposed customer fees and charges, and any other information that PMUC believes would assist the Commission in evaluating this treated wastewater reuse system. These tariffs shall also demonstrate compliance with all applicable requirements of ADEQ and any applicable plumbing codes.”

Page 27, line 6, INSERT New Ordering Paragraph:

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Perkins Mountain Utility Company shall file by July 31, 2009, as a compliance item in this case, appropriate tariffs for Commission consideration that would require the installation of a treated wastewater reuse system that allows for the reuse of such treated wastewater at individual homes. These tariffs shall contain, at a minimum, the requirements for such reuse, details of the estimated costs of construction and operation, proposed customer fees and charges, and any other information that Perkins Mountain Utility Company believes would assist the Commission in evaluating this treated wastewater reuse system. These tariffs shall also demonstrate compliance with all applicable requirements of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality and any applicable plumbing codes.”
