PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 1, 2008, Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. ("Pac-West") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Complaint and Request for Immediate Commission Action against Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"). The parties have a billing dispute under the provisions of their Interconnection Agreement.


At a Procedural Conference that convened on January 21, 2009, the parties reported that they had met with the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") in an attempt to mediate this dispute, and had exchanged settlement offers. Although they had not been able to reach a consensual resolution of this matter, both sides believed that an additional mediation meeting with Staff would benefit the process. Staff agreed to assist the parties. At this point, it appears that the parties will either be able to reach resolution with Staff's assistance, or will need to submit the matter to the Hearing Division for resolution. Rather than establish another status conference on a particular date, it was agreed that following mediation, the parties would file a request for further Commission action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties shall coordinate with Staff to arrange a mutually agreeable time to participate in mediation with Staff, and subsequent thereto, shall file their procedural recommendations for further Commission action.


