In reference to your rate application received on May 3, 2001, this letter is to inform you that your third application submission has not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in Arizona Administrative Code R14-2-103.

On November 15, 2000, a permanent rate increase was filed. It was found deficient on December 14, 2000. On February 7, 2001 the application was resubmitted and found deficient on March 5, 2001. This, your third application was submitted on May 3, 2001 and, it too, has not met the sufficiency requirements. Because of the difficulties in the successful completion of the application, Staff believes you may require additional assistance in this process.

This notice stops the 30-day sufficiency determination period. Staff believes they may provide additional support by assisting you personally with the successful completion of your application.
