PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 14, 2007, CTC Communications Corp. ("CTC") and One Communications Corp. ("OCC") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an "Informational Filing Regarding a Pro Forma Change in Ownership of An Authorized Telecommunications Provider." In the filing, counsel for CTC and OCC stated that a transaction was to occur at the parent holding company level that would dilute the existing ultimate ownership of CTC, although OCC would remain the whole owner of CTC's stock, and CTC's stock would not be directly affected.

Nothing further has been filed in this docket.

Thus, it is appropriate to require the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") to file an update on the status of this matter. In its update, Staff shall include any appropriate recommendations as to how this matter should be resolved and shall state whether this matter should be administratively closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff shall, by May 20, 2009, file an update on this matter. In its update, Staff shall include any appropriate recommendations as to how this matter should be resolved and shall state whether this matter should be administratively closed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.
