PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 28, 2007, Broadview Networks Holdings, Inc. ("Broadview") and A.R.C. Networks, Inc. ("A.R.C.") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") notice of a transaction that might result in the transfer of ownership control of Broadview and the indirect transfer of control of A.R.C., which holds a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide telecommunications services in Arizona.

Nothing further has been filed in this docket.

Thus, it is appropriate to require the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") to file an update on the status of this matter. In its update, Staff shall include any appropriate recommendations as to how this matter should be resolved and shall state whether this matter should be administratively closed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.
