I left a telephone message with your administrative assistant this afternoon regarding the high cost of natural gas for Arizona consumers. Below is a copy of an email I sent to Arizona Corporation Commissioner Stump:

Greetings from Prescott!

I sent the email shown below to Commissioner Stump of the Arizona Corporation Commission:

Dear Commissioner Stump:

I am appealing to you as a "champion of the tax payer". The cost natural gas has more than doubled in the past 3 years for customers of Unisource Energy in Arizona, while the price of natural gas to gas companies has declined more than 50% in the past year. Unisource has applied for and been granted several rate increases as the price of natural gas rose.

Since the cost of their raw materials has been dramatically reduced and Unisource is still receiving increased revenues from its customers, where has this "windfall" of taxpayer and consumer dollars gone? My guess is that most of it has gone to top management and stockholders at the expense of Arizonans trying to make ends meet and heat their homes.

I would appreciate your support in this matter and a reply as to what you and I can do to reduce the cost of natural gas to consumers commensurate with the drop in natural gas prices internationally.
