FOURTH PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 18, 2008, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order ("T.O.") and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Jerome William Carter dba Good Only Done Productions, L.L.C., ("GOD") and Jane Doe Carter, husband and wife, and The Greatest Only Divine Productions, L.L.C. ("GODP") (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("ACT") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of commodity investment contracts and/or investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the T.O. and Notice.

On October 15, 2008, a request for hearing was filed by the Respondents.

On October 17, 2008, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on November 17, 2008.

On November 17, 2008, the Division and Respondents appeared with counsel. The Division has subpoenaed documents from Respondents and the parties are discussing issues raised in the T.O.

1 and Notice. The Division requested that a status conference be scheduled in approximately 45 days.

2 On November 17, 2008, by Procedural order, a status conference was scheduled for January
3 26, 2009.

4 On December 9, 2008, the respective counsel for the Respondents filed an Application to
5 Withdraw as Counsel ("Application") pursuant to ER 1.16(b). Counsel have notified Respondents of
6 the status conference which was previously scheduled for January 26, 2009, at the Commission's
7 offices in Phoenix, Arizona. Counsel also provided the Commission with Respondents' present
8 mailing address.

9 On December 15, 2008, by Procedural Order, the Application was granted.

10 On January 26, 2009, at the status conference, the Division appeared with counsel and Mr.
11 Carter appeared on his own behalf. The Division's counsel indicated the Mr. Carter is scheduled for
12 an Examination Under Oath on February 26, 2009, and the parties are discussing a possible resolution
13 of the proceeding. In the interim, the parties agreed to a hearing being scheduled in May, 2009.

14 Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled on the allegations raised by the Notice.

15 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **hearing** shall be held on **May 11, 2009, at**
16 **10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Room 100, Phoenix,
17 Arizona.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall set aside **May 12, 13, 14 and 15, 2009**, for
19 additional days of hearing, if necessary.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange copies of their Exhibits and
21 Witness Lists by April 10, 2009, with copies provided to the presiding Administrative Law Judge.


