BY THE COMMISSION:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Arizona Public Service Company ("APS ") and Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC") are engaged in providing electric service within portions of Arizona, pursuant to authority granted by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission" or "ACC").
2. On July 31, 2008, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") and Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC") filed a Joint Application and Electric Service Authorization Agreement ("Joint Application") for SSVEC to provide electric service to SBA Structures, Inc. ("SBA"). APS and SSVEC operate pursuant to authority granted by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission").
3. SBA is located within APS' certified territory. According to the Joint Application, the estimated cost to establish the requested service for SBA by APS is \$395,000. The nearest APS facilities are more than 6 miles from SBA. However, SSVEC nearest facilities are 1/2 mile from SBA. The cost to establish the requested service for SBA by SSVEC would be \$31,097.






