STATUS REPORT – WATER SYSTEM  
IMPROVEMENT PLAN

20 Payson Water Company (“Payson Water” or “Company”) hereby submits this  
21 Status Report on the implementation of the Company’s Water System Improvement Plan  
22 (“Plan”) for the Geronimo Estates system, filed in the above-captioned matter on June 20,  
23 2008. In its August 5, 2008 report, Staff recommended that Payson water file the  
24 necessary Approvals to Construct by January 31, 2009. Although the improvements have  
25 been completed, the Company is still waiting to receive the necessary documents from the  
26 Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (“ADEQ”) to file with the Commission.  
Payson Water will file these documents once they are issued by ADEQ. In the

1 meantime, the Company has completed the following improvements identified in the Plan:

- 2           A. Elusive Acres Well (Refurbished): construction, testing and chlorination  
3           complete;
- 4           B. Install additional 10,000 gallons of storage capacity at Geronimo Estates –  
5           complete;
- 6           C. Install second 10,000 gallon storage tank – complete.
- 7           D. Geronimo Estates Well # 1 (Refurbished) – complete.

8           The completion of these system improvements will enhance the water system  
9           serving the Elusive Acres and Geronimo Estates subdivisions, and continue to provide  
10          adequate service to existing customers, as well as anticipated growth. In light of the  
11          evidence presented in this case, Payson Water respectfully requests that the administrative  
12          law judge schedule a procedural conference to discuss the dismissal of the above-  
13          referenced complaints after the ADEQ documents have been filed.
