PROCEDURAL ORDER

11 BY THE COMMISSION:

13 On June 12, 2008, the Arizona Board of Regents on behalf of the University of
14 Arizona ("University of Arizona" or "University") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission
15 ("Commission") the above-captioned Petition for Declaratory Order, seeking an order confirming the
16 University of Arizona's authority to purchase power from a single electric service company and
17 distribute that electricity to all operations throughout its Red Rock Agricultural Center property. The
18 University of Arizona states that it has contracted with Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") to
19 provide electric power to a meter located within APS's service territory, which electricity the
20 University plans to self-distribute within its Red Rock Agricultural Center, including areas within
21 Trico Electric Cooperative Inc.'s ("Trico") service area. Trico objected to the University's decision
22 to purchase power from APS, and claimed that it would be unlawful for APS to deliver power within
23 APS's service territory if that power was then self-distributed to areas within Trico's service area.

24 At a Procedural Conference held on January 22, 2009, the University, Trico and APS reported
25 that they had reached a consensual resolution and have executed an agreement, and that they would
26 be seeking voluntary dismissal of the matter. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") reviewed
27 the agreement did not object to dismissal of this matter.

28 On January 27, 2009, the University filed a Voluntary Request for Dismissal.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this action should be dismissed and the matter
2 administratively closed.


