SECOND
PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 29, 2008, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Wolfepack Transportation, Inc., aka Wolfpack Transportation, Inc. ("Wolfpack") and Michael L. Hairston, Sr. and Sheila Hairston, husband and wife (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of promissory notes.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On December 15, 2008, a request for hearing and Answer were filed by the Respondents.

On December 22, 2008, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on February 5, 2009.

On February 5, 2009, the Division and Respondents appeared with counsel. Counsel for the Division indicated that the Division will attempt to reach a settlement with the Respondents, but requested that a hearing be scheduled in the event that a Consent Order is not approved by the Commission prior to the hearing.

1 Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **hearing** shall be held on **June 1, 2009, at 10:00 a.m.**,
3 at the Commission's office, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room #1, Phoenix, Arizona.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall also reserve June 2, 3, 4 and 5, 2009, for
5 additional days of hearing, if necessary.


6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **Division and Respondents shall exchange copies of**
7 **their Exhibits and Witness Lists**, with courtesy copies provided to the presiding Administrative
8 Law Judge, by **May1, 2009**.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ex parte rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113—Unauthorized
10 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
11 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

12 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the**
13 **Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law**
14 **and admission *pro hac vice*.**

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
16 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
17 ruling at hearing.


