Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105 and the January 12, 2009, Procedural Order issued in the above-captioned matter, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC" or "Cooperative"), by and through counsel undersigned, hereby applies to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an order granting it leave to intervene in this proceeding. In support of its Motion, SSVEC states the following:

1. SSVEC is an Arizona member-owned non-profit rural electric distribution cooperative headquartered in Willcox, Arizona.
2. SSVEC is a Class A electric public service corporation that serves most of Cochise County and portions of Santa Cruz, Pima, and Graham Counties, pursuant to a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission.
3. In this docket, The Solar Alliance has applied for a declaratory order that providers of electricity in conjunction with certain solar service agreements would not be public service corporations.


