First objection is to the increase in basic rate from \$15.00 to \$30.00 per meter. Competitors in the area are charging \$30.00 however their meters are placed 1 per acre while Beaver Dam Water Co. place meters at 4 per acre. Therefore this represents a rate of \$120.00 per acre with competitors at \$30.00 per acre.

Second objection is to the escalation of cost based on usage. Although the \$3.00/first 4,000 gallons is reasonable, the escalation beyond this rate is excessive. Current rate is a flat \$1.50/1,000 gallons and therefore this escalation (up to \$4.75/1,000) represents a 300% increase in the higher usage rates. My January 2009 water bill was ~\$38.00; under the rate increase proposal, my bill would increase to ~\$88.00 for the same amount of water.

My final objection is based on the fact that there is no emergency back-up power.
