Dear Commissioners:

As a small business owner and an Arizona Public Service customer, I urge you to require that APS invest more of our ratepayer dollars in energy efficiency as part of the APS rate case and to increase energy efficiency requirements as part of the Commission workshops on energy efficiency.

While we expect electric rates to keep going up it is important to provide businesses the necessary tools to reduce their electric bills and manage their energy usage. Improving energy efficiency is by far the cheapest measure for reducing energy demands and is at least half the price of building new power plants.
