PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 20, 2007, Wickenburg Ranch Water, LLC ("Wickenburg Ranch") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application to Adjust Rates.

On February 12, 2009, the Commission issued Decision No. 70741.

On February 26, 2009, Wickenburg Ranch filed an Application for Rehearing specifically requesting that certain portions of Decision No. 70741 be deleted and that one conclusion of law be revised.

On March 16, 2009, the Commission issued Decision No. 70832, granting Wickenburg Ranch's Application for Rehearing and directing the Hearing Division to conduct a procedural conference at which recommendations as to the processes to be followed for the rehearing may be presented.

Thus, it is now appropriate to schedule a procedural conference to allow Wickenburg Ranch and the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") to present recommendations as to the processes that should be followed concerning the rehearing in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** in this matter shall be held on **April 22, 2009, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, in the 2nd Floor Conference Room at the Commission's Offices at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, for the purpose of allowing Wickenburg Ranch and Staff to present their recommendations as to the processes that should be followed concerning the rehearing in this matter.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
2 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
3 *pro hac vice*.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
5 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
6 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
8 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
9 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearing at
10 all hearings, procedural conferences, and Open Meetings at which the matter is scheduled for
11 discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative
12 Law Judge or the Commission.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
14 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
