PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On June 30, 2008, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC" or "Cooperative") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a rate increase.

On August 18, 2008, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that set this matter for hearing on April 21, 2009, and established a schedule for filing testimony.

On March 12, 2009, the Commission's Utilities Division ("staff") filed a Motion to extend the Time to File Surrebuttal Testimony related to rate design, as the witness responsible for such testimony has a conflicting deadline to file testimony in another pending rate case. Staff requested a one week extension to file Mr. Musgrove's testimony until April 10, 2009.

On March 18, 2009, SSVEC filed a Response to Staff's Motion. The Cooperative does not oppose Staff's request based on the understanding all other Staff testimony will be filed on April 3, 2009, as scheduled. SSVEC also requests that Staff provide a copy of the Musgrove Surrebuttal Testimony to SSVEC via e-mail on April 10, 2009.

Under the circumstances, Staff's request is reasonable and should be granted.


1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **deadline to file Mr. Musgroves' Surrebuttal**  
2 **Testimony** on behalf of Staff is **extended until April 10, 2009.**

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other Surrebuttal Testimony will be filed according to  
4 the original schedule on April 3, 2009.

5 IT IS FURHTER ORDERED that Staff shall work with the Cooperative and use its best  
6 efforts to send the Musgrove Surrebuttal Testimony to the Cooperative via e-mail on April 10, 2009.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
8 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


