I wish to intervene, on behalf of EnerNOC, Inc., in the investigation of Regulatory and Rate Incentives for Gas & Electric Utilities. I attended, on behalf of EnerNOC, Inc., the March 6, 2009 Energy Efficiency Workshop. EnerNOC provides both demand response and targeted energy efficiency services, in the form of monitoring based commissioning for commercial and industrial customers.

Of particular interest were the comments made at the March 6 workshop in regard to increasing the amount of energy efficiency (MWh) as well as decreasing peak demand (MWs) associated with the anticipated doubling of demand in Arizona over the next two decades to approximately 32,000 MWs. EnerNOC finds the conversation of increasing energy efficiency and examining incentives or decoupling to encourage expanded utility and cooperative contributions an important, and necessary, dialogue to have. However, EnerNOC hopes that the Corporation Commission will include demand response as one of the tools, in addition to energy efficiency, that can be used to address the goal of decreasing peak demand, reducing the need for new infrastructure and reducing greenhouse gas emissions. EnerNOC provides demand response services to many utilities in the West, and nationally. DR can be viewed as a resource and an alternative to costly peaking facilities. We respectfully request that demand response be included in this important discussion and that EnerNOC's request for intervention be granted.


