Good Afternoon-

For over 14 years, I have lived in Scottsdale. Recently, I was alerted to the possibility of a cell phone company, Newpath, coming into the community to upgrade the existing wireless network. In speaking with many of my neighbors, I am excited at the possibility of increasing the existing cell phone network in my neighborhood.

I attended a recent neighborhood meeting in which Newpath hosted a community information session to further inform the residents of the possible changes and upgrades. It appears to me, from what I heard and have subsequently been told, that Newpath has been working closely with our city officials to transparently navigate the municipal bureaucracy. It is my understanding that their case is currently pending at the Arizona Corporation Commission, and I would like to formally support the proposed project as presented by Newpath.

Initially, I was skeptical that the proposed upgrades would bring massive cell towers or obtrusive structures to our desert neighborhood. After attending the meeting, however, I am confident that the improvements Newpath is proposing will greatly benefit our community. The proposed cell structures either attach to existing structures, such as a street light, or are actually extremely well disguised as a cactus. In reviewing many of the past projects Newpath has completed, I was often unable to differentiate between their 'cell' cacti and the legitimate counterpart. I believe Newpath has been a responsible corporate ally and I hope you will ensure the success and approval of their project.
