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

ACC Decision No. 70955 (Docket No. W-20453A-06-0247 et al.)

Dear Mr. Huff:

On April 7, 2009, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision No. 70955 (“Order”), granting Northern Sunrise Water Company (“NSWC” or “Company”) and Southern Sunrise Water Company an extension of their respective certificates of convenience and necessity (“CC&N”).

As you are aware, the Commission approved the inclusion of the Babocomari area in NSWC’s CC&N in Decision No. 68826 (June 29, 2006). Pursuant to that decision, the Company was required to provide copies of all Approvals to Construct (“ATC”) for the Babocomari area to Commission Staff as a condition of approval. However, in its recent Order, the Commission extended the current deadline to file these documents (June 29, 2009) for another three years, to April 7, 2012. In addition, the Company must now also file a copy of a Physical Availability Determination or Letter of Adequate Water Supply for each individual development within the Babocomari area. Any Babocomari developer who has not obtained these required documents by the April 7, 2012 deadline will likely have his or her property deleted from NSWC’s CC&N.

In addition to informing you and the Babocomari Group of the new conditions placed on the extension of water utility service within the Babocomari area, I am also writing to follow up on certain issues raised by Commissioner Paul Newman during the March 31, 2009 Open Meeting. Commissioner Newman informed the Company that there were several issues discussed during Cochise County proceedings regarding the location of the Babocomari area within floodplains, and the creation of a road district to deal with water drainage issues. Please provide me with more information concerning these two issues to ensure that they do not adversely affect the planning of water utility infrastructure in the event development activity is reinitiated in the Babocomari area.

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
